# Regulations.



## CYCLING.

1. All races are run under the Rules of the Goldfields League of Wheelmen.

2. Protests in reference to any event must be made in writing and handed to the Judge within 10 minutes after the conclusion of each event, and shall be accompanied by a deposit of 5s. or it will not be entertained, which deposit shall be forfeited if the protest is considered frivolous. Such protest to be dealt with by the Judge and Racing and Record Committee. Any appeal from their decision to be made through the Judge to the Appeal Board of the League, accompanied by a further deposit of 10s., within fifteen minutes of the receipt of such decision, and such deposit to be forfeited if the protest be decided against him.

3. Competitors must report themselves to the Number 1 Steward before each event, and also wear numbers corresponding to their number on the programme. Any competitor failing to do this will be disqualified.

4. All races will be started punctually at times stated on the programme, and any competitor not appearing on the track at such time shall not be allowed to start. No exceptions will be made to this rule.

5. Immediately after start of each race the Competitors' Attendants must proceed to enclosure provided. Any infringement of this rule will render both Competitor and Attendant liable to disqualification.

6. None but Competitors and Attendants (who will be provided with a ticket) will be allowed in the dressing rooms.

7. The following will be the signals used :—

Bell	...	...	Five minutes before race
Whistle	...	...	Mount machine
Pistol fire	...	...	Start
Bell	...	...	Last lap
Pistol fire	...	...	Finish

The following are the time limits fixed by the Goldfields' League of Wheelmen for the undermentioned cycle events :—

Half-mile	...	..	1 minute 15 seconds
One mile	..	..	2 " 30 "
Two miles	...	...	5 "

If the above time-limits are exceeded in Heats or Finals the management retain the option of with-holding prize money.
